The Development Gateway Portal

A platform for information and knowledge exchange:

- Topic Pages -- knowledge sharing communities
- dgMarket – e-tenders from around the world
- Country Gateways- locally owned and managed web portals for development
- AiDA – “ Accessible Information on Development Activities” (largest online global directory of development projects and activities.)
- Local Projects Database (LPD) - helps organizations coordinate development projects and activities
- Aid Management Platform (AMP) – will help countries and donors manage resource allocations for development activities
- E-Government grants – to improve government processes in developing nations



Usage is Increasing...

- The portal has close to 145,000 registered users (53% increase during past 12 months)
- Over 311,670 unique visitors in January 2005
- Averaging 1.4 million page views per month
- 55% of registered members are from developing countries
