

ON-SITE

On-site registrants will be charged an additional administration fee of US\$50.00. Forms of payment accepted on-site are: credit cards (Mastercard, Visa, American Express, Discover & Diners Club), traveler's checks and company checks.

GALA DINNER

The 2005 Summit opening Gala Dinner will be held on June 21, 2005. Due to anticipated high attendance, participants will be seated in both the Grand Ballroom and the Harborside Ballroom of the conference venue. The program will transmitted on closed circuit television in the Harborside Ballroom.

CCA will attempt to seat participants that fully register during Early Bird registration (until April 15th) in the Grand Ballroom, however due to space limitations, seating in this venue can not be guaranteed.

STATE BANQUET

All wire transfer transaction information must be brought to the Summit.


INTERNATIONAL ATTENDEES

CCA has alerted the U.S. Departments of Homeland Security and State, as well as U.S. embassies abroad.

If you do not hold a passport from a visa-waiver country, you are strongly encouraged to contact the nearest U.S. embassy or U.S. consulate as soon as possible to schedule an interview for a visa. The visa process can be lengthy.

You MUST have a valid visa to enter the United States. CCA cannot provide any additional assistance concerning the procurement of a visa. The decision is wholly a matter for the U.S. embassy in your country.


